

ITTP-SEC PATHWAY IMPLEMENTATION CHECKLIST

Identify a sponsor at each college to own and drive the ITTP-Sec adoption process

Use ITTP-Sec documentation as guideline for implementation and communication

- ITTP-Sec Diagram – provides an overview of the pathway courses, certifications and IT jobs.
 - ITTP-Sec Course Guide – provides detail of each course, certification, course description, and the associated CID number for each course.
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Identify any ITTP-Sec course that are missing from the current college catalog offerings.

Add missing courses to college catalog:

- Work with Curriculum Committee to define course descriptions, and have courses added to catalog. (WebCMS)
- Ensure that new course curriculum meet requirements for specified industry certifications. (ie. A+, Network+, etc)
- Use C-ID descriptors and prerequisites to ensure later C-ID approval

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Work with college Articulation Officer to have your courses approved by the C-ID program to ensure articulation and transfer of your courses to other California higher educational institutions:

- Develop course outlines for each course using C-ID descriptors as a guideline
- Ensure prerequisites match C-ID descriptors
- Articulation officer
